nurse practitioner walk-in

program overview

The walk-in service is available to all clients of the Family Health Team. This service runs daily Monday to Friday from 8:30am - 11:30am. It is intended for clients experiencing minor, non-life threatening illness or injury. Visits are short and are able to only address one problem at a time.

when to attend the walk-in clinic?

A walk-in clinic visit would be appropriate for minor allergic reactions, medication concerns, minor injuries, minor illness, rashes, minor burns, minor infections, small wounds, cough, fever, etc.

Visits that are NOT appropriate for the walk-in clinic would include: chronic illness (old injuries, maintenance of diabetes etc.), medication adjustments, severe pain, complete physicals, physical assessments required for work or school or pre-ops, workers compensation or any other forms.

Using this service appropriately ensures that all clients can be seen in a timely fashion and that each person's needs can be met by the appropriate provider.
